


#### Suicide

#### Hippocratic Corpus

The HippocraticOath also prohibits:



- surgery, even on sufferers from stone
- abortive remedies
- sex with patients or family members
- taking fees for teaching medicine
- only permits teaching male students



## Ignatius of Antioch










## Physician-assisted suicide Death with Dignity; aid-in-dying



#### Physician Assisted Suicide



- STATES WITH MEASURES/RULINGS AUTHORIZING PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE
- STATES WHERE PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE IS ILLEGAL
- O STATES WHERE PRACTICE IS NOT LEGAL, BUT THAT LACK STATUTES EXPLICITLY BANNING IT
