

+ 150 by the patients General Practitioner





#### Dutch Right to Die society

- Founded in 1973:
- > 160.000 members (1% of population)



#### LevenseindeKLINIEK founded by the NVVE

- 2010: Feasibility study End-of-life clinic
- 2011: September 01: Project start
- 2012: March 01: Effective start of the End-of-life clinic



19x Nurse general


4x Nurse terminal care / technical team

NB: 25 physicians are also SCEN physician


All-in part-time mployment (8 hrs /week)


### Applications (12 months totals)




### Applications by diagnosis

- 33% Other somatic diseases




